Dial **211** for Iowa Alliance of Information and Referral Systems for counseling, crisis intervention, homeless assistance, health and human services information.



Dial **411** for Local Directory Assistance to request any number in the United States.



Dial **511** for Iowa's Travel Information to access road & traffic conditions from the Iowa Department of Transportation and the Iowa State Patrol for the entire state, a region within Iowa, a city/town, or highway.



Dial **611** for Grand Mound Cooperative Telephone Association and Grand Mound Communications Company's customer and repair service.



Dial **711** for Relay Iowa service for communication between hearing, deaf, hard-of-hearing and speech impaired persons.



Dial **811** to access the One Call Services to have the underground facilities located and marked for digging to protect pipeline and utilities from excavation damage.



Dial **911** for fire, police or emergency medical services.

Google Search Tips

- Want to look up the residential number of someone who called you? Enter it this way: *phonebook:563-847-1234*
- If you want to know where the area code of a phone number is located, just enter the three number area code. Example: *563*
- If you want to look for a phrase such as *employee communications*, you might be better off doing a search explicitly for the phrase by enclosing the words in double quote marks like this: *"employee communications"*.
- If you want to exclude a word from your search, use a " - " (minus) sign in front of the word. For instance, if you wanted to search for *inspirational*, but wanted to exclude the word *religious*, you would search for *inspirational-religion*.
